# Morning Activity: D&T/Art

## How could we make a lantern?

We began by thinking about events linked to light such as Diwali, bonfire night and Christmas and how lights are used in each of them.

Following this we carefully selected pieces of willow and created a lantern frame in the shape of a pyramid by joining the willow with string and tape. Then we covered the frame in different coloured tissue paper to allow the light to shine through.











# Morning Activity: Science & Art

## What do different leaves look like?

We continued our learning about leaves by looking carefully at our clay impressions. We all shared our impressions with each other and we were able to identify the trees they came from.

We used paints to decorate the clay impressions. We used thin paintbrushes to carefully follow the veins of the leaves. We think they look beautiful!

We completed our lanterns and leaf paintings.

Then we made bird feeders to encourage a variety of birds to visit our school grounds.

We threaded dried fruit and then selected where to hang them in the trees.
