I have been a teacher and headteacher in a number of Sheffield and Derbyshire schools in my career and I worked with the local authority as a school adviser; I was Principal Primary Adviser when I left in 2008.

Since leaving the local authority I have worked independently as a school improvement adviser and still enjoy working with a small number of local schools. I am also Chair of Governors at Rowan School (a special school for children with speech and language difficulties) and I serve on a number of local committees as the special-school governor representative. Recently I have been contributing to the governing body at Acres Hill School as well on their journey to becoming an academy. I am a Local Leader of Governance – a small group of governors that support schools in Sheffield.

I have loved working in education and now find myself very busy serving as a governor. I really enjoy being part of the education community in Stannington.
