Mathematical Understanding

Multiplication and Division - We will be learning how to recognise and use equal groups to multiply and divide. We will be learning to multiply using arrays and divide by sharing or grouping.

Fractions - We will be applying our division skills to help us find halves, thirds and quarters of shapes and amounts.

Statistics - We will learn how to gather and organise data into charts and graphs and then answer questions about what it shows.

Understanding the arts

Music – We will be learning to play musical instruments, including the recorder with Mrs Grayson.

Dance - We will be developing our Dance skills.

Art – Do know any famous artists from Sheffield? We will be learning about Joe Peel and looking at their work. We will also be choosing our favourite pieces. We will then be able to recreate a piece of our own in their style.

Understanding English, Communication and Languages

During the first half term we will be reading Flat Stanley and our writing will be linked to this book.

Character descriptions – Have you seen Flat Stanley? He doesn't look like a usual little boy! How would you describe him?

Narrative – What would happen if you woke up to find you were flat? What adventures would you go on? Read our stories to find out.

Persuasive writing –We will be writing to persuade you why you should live in Sheffield.

Poetry – We will be writing our own poems and reading them out loud to other classes.

Historical, Geographical and Social Understanding

Geography –We will be exploring our local area using maps, aerial images and fieldwork (local walk). Do you think you could create your own map? We will be! We will be comparing the UK with a non-European country.

History – Do you know what Sheffield was like 100 years ago? We will be finding out about what it was like to live in Sheffield 100 years ago.

Imagine living in the Victorian times! What would school be like? What toys would you play with?

Do you know which Monarch ruled in the Victorian times? We will be learning about Queen Victoria and ordering the events in her life to develop chronology.

Science and Technological Understanding

Science – Can you name a reptile? Do you know which animals are omnivores or how we classify them? What is a lifecycle? We will be learning about plants and animals and carrying out our own investigations to answer these questions.

ICT – We will be using google to locate streets and places in Sheffield. We will learn how to stay safe online. Can you programme a beetbot? We will be writing algorithms (a set of clear concise instructions) to create as well as draw shapes on the PurpleMash programme.

Religious Education

We will be comparing different Christian places of worship as well as places of worship from different religions. Have you ever been to a place of worship? A Chapel or a Mosque? We will also be looking at the importance of prayer in religion and thinking about why people pray.

Enrichment

We will be visiting the Victorian Classroom and the Medina Mosque this term to support our learning.

Understanding Physical Development, Health and Wellbeing

PE -. We will be working on balancing skills this half term. Can you maintain a balance along a line without wobbling? Try it! Remember- minimum wobble! We will continue to develop our gymnastic skills as well.
