Some reminders.....

Reading

Reading books and diaries: - please read with your child at least three times per week. Reading books will be sent home on Monday and these need to be returned to school on Thursday each week. Rising Stars online reading library will continue to be available for KS1. If you need help to access this please email your class teacher. This will be available for FS after half term: - Further details to follow.

Reading diaries: Please complete each time you read with your child and then send into school on 5th October (returned home Friday 9th October) for staff to view. Then please return them to school again on 23rd November. We will not be issuing the reading book marks and stickers at present.

Home Learning

KS1:- home learning will be sent via Parentmail each week commencing Friday 11th September. Children will receive maths facts to practise for instant recall and a set of spellings to learn. A home learning book will be provided but this does not need to be sent into school. Children can also access Purple Mash, Spelling Shed and TT Rockstars at home to support this. Home learning will be followed up with the children in class in the form of quick weekly assessments and transfer into ongoing work.

P.E.

On your child's allocated PE days please make sure that they come in **jogging bottoms or leggings** and **sports shoes** with a school t shirt and sweatshirt or cardigan as we will not, initially, be changing for PE.

COVID-19

Symptoms & planning for outbreaks

- The most important symptoms of Coronavirus are: a new continuous cough; a high temperature; a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).

If you think your child has any of these symptoms, **PLEASE DO NOT SEND THEM TO SCHOOL**. If we believe a child in school has symptoms, we will send them home.

- If anyone in your household develops symptoms, they must self-isolate. You should then get a test; these are most effective within the first 3 days of developing symptoms. To organise this, go to: <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/testing-and-tracing>

- If the test is positive, please inform school and self-isolate for 10 days; everyone else in the household must self-isolate for 14 days. If the test result is negative, they can return to school as long as they feel well (no temperature) and have not been in contact with anyone who has tested positive.

- If we have a confirmed case of Coronavirus, we will inform Public Health and follow their advice. Everyone within that group (staff and pupils) will be informed and asked to self-isolate as above. The other family members of children in that group do not need to self-isolate unless the person isolating develops symptoms.

- The person with the positive test result will be contacted and asked to engage with the NHS Test & Trace service and provide details about recent close contacts.

- As you will have no doubt seen in the news, there is the possibility of a 'local lockdown' if cases in our area start to rise again. If this happens, we will inform you of our plans as soon as possible.
