COVID-19



If your child has: a high temperature a new, continuous cough, or a loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste

> This could be a sign of coronavirus

> > **Book a test**

If your child has: a runny nose, is sneezing or feeling unwell But they don't have: a high temperature a new, continuous cough, or a loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste

These are not normally symptoms of coronavirus

Seek advice from a pharmacy, dial 111 or see your GP

If you think your child has any of these symptoms, PLEASE DO NOT SEND THEM TO SCHOOL. If we believe a child in school has symptoms, we will send them home.

• If anyone in your household develops symptoms, they must self-isolate. You should then get a test; these are most effective within the first 3 days of developing symptoms. To organise this, go to: <u>https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/testing-and-tracing</u>

• If the test is positive, please inform school and self-isolate for 10 days; everyone else in the household must self-isolate for 14 days. If the test result is negative, they can return to school as long as they feel well (no temperature) and have not been in contact with anyone who has tested positive.

• If we have a confirmed case of Coronavirus, we will inform Public Health and follow their advice. Everyone within that group (staff and pupils) will be informed and asked to self-isolate as above. The other family members of children in that group do not need to self-isolate unless the person isolating develops symptoms.

• The person with the positive test result will be contacted and asked to engage with the NHS Test & Trace service and provide details about recent close contacts.

• As you will have no doubt seen in the news, there is the possibility of a 'local lockdown' if cases in our area start to rise again. If this happens, we will inform you of our plans as soon as possible.

<u>HOME LEARNING</u>:- If your child has to self-isolate and are well enough to continue learning a pack of materials will be emailed to you or can be printed for someone to collect on your behalf

In order to reduce the amount of materials going to and coming from home please read the following:-

Reading

Reading books and diaries: - please read with your child at least three times per week. Reading books will be sent home on Mondays and these need to be returned to school on Thursday each week. You do not need to send in reading diaries each week. Rising Stars online reading library will continue to be available for all children. If you need help to access this please email your class teacher.

Reading diaries: Please complete each time you read with your child and then send into school on 5th October (returned home Friday 9th October) for staff to view. **Please can all children return them to school again on 23rd November**. We will not be issuing the reading book marks and stickers at present.

Home Learning

KS1:- Home learning will be sent via Parentmail on Friday each week. Children will receive maths facts to practise for instant recall and a set of spellings to learn. A home learning book will be provided **but this does not need to be sent into school.** Children can also access Purple Mash, Spelling Shed and TT Rockstars at home to support this. Home learning will be followed up with the children in class in the form of quick weekly assessments and transfer into ongoing work.

FS:- Home learning will be sent via Parentmail on Friday each week. Please complete this in your purple home learning book and if you wish to share any learning your child is doing at home please do so via Tapestry.

Toys and show and tell

May we also remind parents that although we have allowed children to bring a small pocket-sized plastic toy for playtimes, at this present time please refrain from sending in items for show and tell. However, if you want to email a photograph of something children have done etc then staff can share this with the class.

Parking outside school

PARKING INCORRECTLY OUTSIDE SCHOOL CAUSES A REAL HAZARD TO YOUNG CHILDREN

May I remind parents that parking opposite school is not permitted – <u>where the two white line markings are in</u> <u>the centre of the road, even though one is a broken one</u>. Please respect the yellow zig-zag lines – these reinforce the no parking restrictions and are there to make the area safe for our children.

You may park on Greaves Lane, or on the lower part of Stannington Road, clear of the school gates, where the single white lines are. <u>Please do not park on Hanmoor Road</u>, which is a private road or in the school car park. If parents repeatedly park illegally we will be forced to note registrations and inform the police.

Please only use the disabled space outside school if you are a blue badge holder.



Please adhere to the 20mph speed restriction in place around school.
