Parking outside school

PARKING INCORRECTLY OUTSIDE SCHOOL CAUSES A REAL HAZARD TO YOUNG CHILDREN

May I remind parents that parking opposite school is not permitted – where the two white line markings are in the centre of the road, even though one is a broken one. Please respect the yellow zig-zag lines – these reinforce the no parking restrictions and are there to make the area safe for our children.

<u>Please do not park on Hanmoor Road</u>, which is a private road or in the school car park. If parents repeatedly park illegally we will be forced to note registrations and inform the police.
