

Key Question

What do you know about the United Kingdom?

Mathematical Understanding

Multiplication and Division - We will be learning about how to recognise and use equal groups to multiply and divided. We will be learning to multiply using arrays and divide by sharing or grouping.

Fractions - We will be applying our division skills to help us find halves, thirds and quarters of shapes and amounts.

Statistics - We will learn how gather and organise data into charts and graphs and then answer questions about what it shows.

Understanding the arts

Music - London's Burning, London's Burning - we will be learning the words to this song as well as other songs about places in our country.

Art -After looking at paintings by JMW Turner, who was famous for his wonderful skies and seascapes, we will be recreating scenes from the Great Fire of London using a 'Turner style' sky background. We will then add different buildings by printing on top of our background skies using a technique based on lino printing and linking to the work of local artist James Green.

Understanding English, Communication and Languages

During the first half term we will be reading Fantastic Mr Fox and our writing will be linked to this book.

Character descriptions - Have you met Mr Fox? He is the most mischievous fox I know!

Narrative - What would you do if you had a whole farm to yourself? We can write our very own adventures!

Historical recounts - What happened during those fateful few days in 1666? Read our recounts to find out!

Poetry - We will be writing our own fire poems and reading them out loud to other classes.

Science and Technological Understanding

Science - As well as learning about animals, including humans we will also be revisiting some of our learning about materials and which are best to fit a particular purpose, linking to DT and our work on the Great Fire of London.

D.T. - What did houses look like in 1666? Can you build a fire engine? We will be learning how to make axles by designing and making a fire engine.

ICT - We will learn how to stay safe online. Can you programme a beetbot? We will be writing algorithms and learning how to debug them!

Religious Education

We are learning about religious symbols with a focus on Christianity, Judaism and Islam. We will be comparing different Christian places of worship as well as places of worship from different religions. Have you ever been to a place of worship?

Enrichment

We are hoping to visit places of worship in the second half of the term to support our RE learning. Watch this space!

Historical, Geographical and Social Understanding

Geography -What country do we live in? We will be using our map skills to locate the countries and cities that make up the United Kingdom. We will also be looking at key human and physical features of the UK including some famous landmarks!

History - What happened during the days and nights of the Great Fire of London? We will find out by plotting the events on a timeline. Has London always looked like it does now? What did it look like in 1666? We will be finding out and making comparisons

Social Understanding - Did anything good come out of the Great Fire? What about the end of the plague?

PE - We will be revisiting our gymnastic skills this term. As part of our REAL PE we will be thinking about balancing. Can you maintain a balance along a line without wobbling? Try it! Remember- minimum wobble.
