Key Question

What impact have Charles Darwin and David Attenborough had on our world?

Mathematical Understanding

Fractions - We will be applying our division skills to help us find halves, thirds and quarters of shapes and amounts.
Time – We will be learning how to tell the time to the nearest 15 minutes and some of us to the nearest 5 minutes. We will be learning about periods of time as well.

 $\ensuremath{\textbf{Capacity}}$ – We will be learning about capacity and what a litre and millilitre are.

Position and Direction – We will be learning about turns and how they can be clockwise and anti-clockwise direction.

Understanding English, Communication and Languages

During the first half term we will be reading The Proudest Blue and our writing will be linked to this book.

Character descriptions – Who are Asiya and Faizah? We will be writing a description all about them so it is almost as if you know them!

Narrative – What makes you proud? We will be retelling the story from Asiya or Faizah's point of view. Non Chronological reports – Do you know which animals live on the Galapagos Islands? We do and will tell you all about them!

Science and Technological Understanding

Science – As well as learning about plants and how they grow we will be learning about living things and their habitats. Most of our science learning will be done through Forest Schools.

D.T. – Do you know the difference between a fixed and rotational axle? We will be finding out by using one when we design and make a sustainable bus for the future.

ICT – We will learn how to stay safe online. How do you organise data so you can answer a question? We will be learning how to use a branching programme.
