## Key Question

What impact have Charles Darwin and David Attenborough had on our world?

#### Mathematical Understanding

 $\ensuremath{\text{Money}}$  - We will be learning to identify coins and make the same amounts using different coins

**Time** – We will be learning how to tell the time to the nearest 15 minutes and some of us to the nearest 5 minutes. We will be learning about periods of time as well.

**Capacity** – We will be learning about capacity and what a litre and millilitre are.

**Position and Direction** – We will be learning about turns and how they can be clockwise and anti-clockwise direction.

#### Understanding English, Communication and Languages

During the first half term we will be reading the traditional tale of Little Red Riding Hood. Our writing will be linked to this book.

**Character descriptions** – Who is Little Red Riding Hood and what is she really like? How 'bad' is the wolf? We will be writing a description of our favourite character.

**Narrative** – We will be writing our own endings to Little Red Riding Hood.

**Non-Chronological reports** – We are learning all about the bees in our garden and creating a book of bee facts. We are going to be Bee Experts!

#### Science and Technological Understanding

**Science** – As well as learning about plants and how they grow we will be learning about living things and their habitats. Most of our science learning will be done through Forest Schools.

D.T. – Do you know the difference between a fixed and rotational axle? We will be finding out by using one when we design and make a sustainable vehicle for tourist trips.
ICT – We will learn how to stay safe online. Can you make a stop start animation? We are going to be learning how to do that this term as well.
